During Term Two in Inquiry Learning, all classes have settled in well and students are investigating various topics.

Our Inquiry focus for Term 2 is CIVICS (Civics and Citizenship).

#### Foundation~ Families

Students will explore and learn about their family, and how it contributes to them being safe and healthy individuals. They learn about and celebrate special cultural days, including significant celebrations in Australia.

#### Years 1 & 2~ I Rule, You Rule, We Rule

Students will explore the meaning of right and wrong, good and bad, the types of acts often considered right and those often considered wrong, and the reasons why they are considered so.

Middle School:

#### Years 3 & 4 ~ Civics: Rights, Responsibilities and Participation

Students explain how decisions can be made democratically and the role of local government. They recognise the importance of rules and distinguish between rules and laws. They describe how people participate in their community as active citizens and the factors that shape a person's identity and sense of belonging.

Senior School:

#### Years 5 & 6~ Who Rules?

Students investigate and explore the roles and responsibilities of the three levels of government: Local, State and Federal. They explore and respond to current political issues.

Please take the opportunity and time to discuss your child's learning journey nightly, as often learning is reinforced when children share their daily learning

Have a great week everyone and look forward to saying hi to you out in the yard during the week.


