Principal's Message

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Annual Implementation Plan for Term 2

This is an update on the annual implementation plan (AIP) for the term. The staff created the AIP and consulted with regional support to support the goals in our strategic plan for the school. The 2024 AIP was presented to the school council last term and attested. This term, the Westbreen team will continue to focus on our Numeracy program and creating learning progressions for our mathematical units for our learners. We also have a focus on Professional Learning Communities. The teaching teams are working this term to evaluate our PLC approach and how we target our students' learning, especially in Reading. We are also working on wellbeing and taking a deep dive into Effective Teaching and Learning Practices at the school.

Staff Update

Jason Kenny will take leave during Weeks 4-7 this term. This leave was planned and organised leading into Term 2. During this time, Kristy Monaghan will be acting as the Assistant Principal. Ms Bronwyn Collister will join the team for the four weeks to support the Tutor program in Kristy's absence. This is an important part of the support that Westbreen PS provides to our learners.

We have some news regarding NAPLAN. Individual student reports will be available after July 15, 2024, for current Year 3 and 5 students who participated in NAPLAN this year. Additionally, our Year 4-6 students will take the Attitudes to School survey during Week 8 this year. We'll provide more information closer to the dates.




